



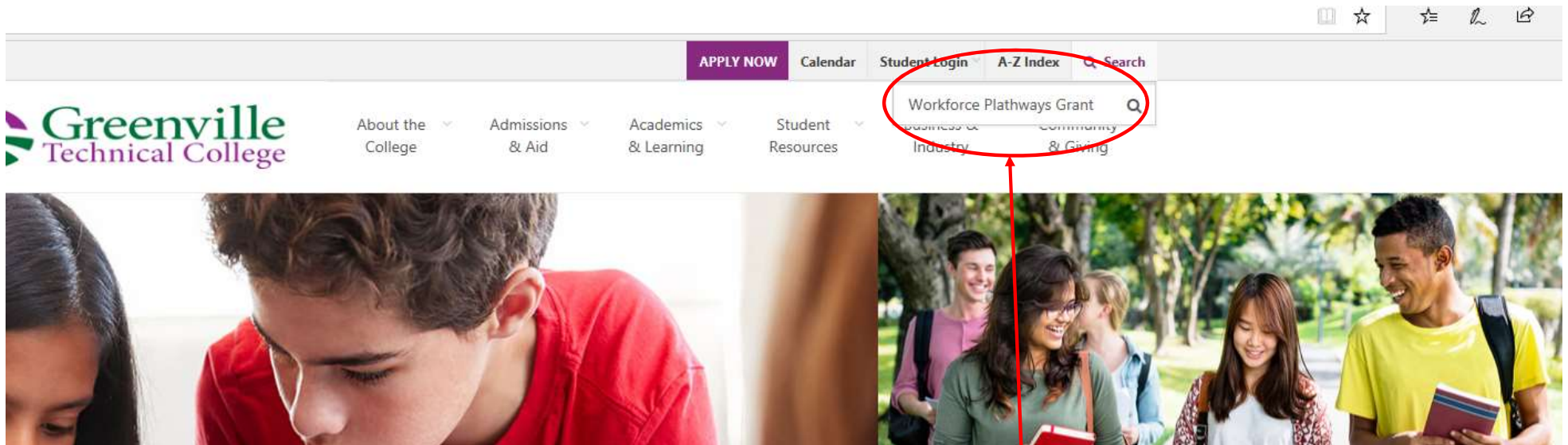

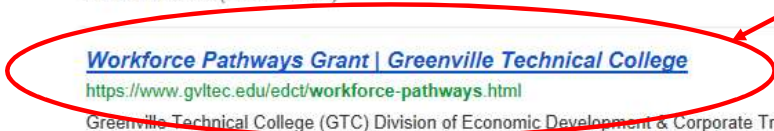

Workforce Pathways Grant

Greenville Technical College (GTC) Division of Economic Development & Corporate Training is pleased to offer the Workforce Pathways Grant. This grant program is only available for a limited time period or until funds are expended.

The Workforce Pathways Grant is funded by the South Carolina General Assembly through the South Carolina Technical College System. It covers the cost of class tuition for eligible GTC continuing education courses in the areas of Advanced Manufacturing, Logistics and Skilled Trades, Health Care, Environmental/Safety and Business & Leadership. Courses are subject to change based on availability.

Funds are available to students who are current South Carolina residents and can only be used to pay for class tuition for eligible GTC continuing education workforce training courses.
